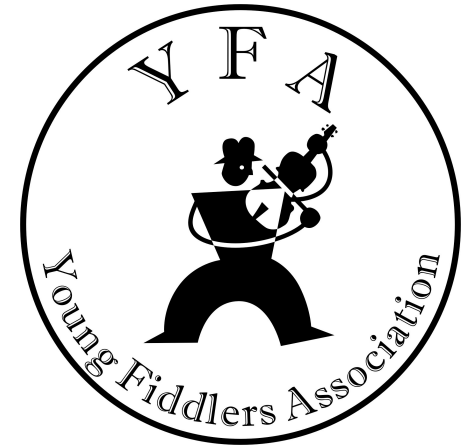

Who can come to YFA workshops and jam
Any fiddler age 8-18. Come and try us out!

Do I have to be a member before I come a YFA gathering? No! Non-members are welcome to attend workshops and jam sessions for a fee. Members receive a discount on the events.

What does it cost? New annual memberships are \$50 (\$70 for a family) and include the 2008-2009 (used again) CD and music book with the jam tunes, a T-shirt, discounts on workshops, and free jam sessions. Renewal memberships are \$40 (\$60 for a family) and includes a T-shirt and discounts on workshops and free jam sessions. After each workshop the workshop tunes will be posted on the YFA website. **Half-year membership for January-May, reduce by \$10.**

Am I good enough to join? We welcome all fiddle students with basic playing skills to join our fiddle community.

Can teachers become members of the YFA? Supporting teacher membership, which includes a listing on our website, is open to any fiddle teacher who volunteers for YFA. Teacher memberships are \$10.
